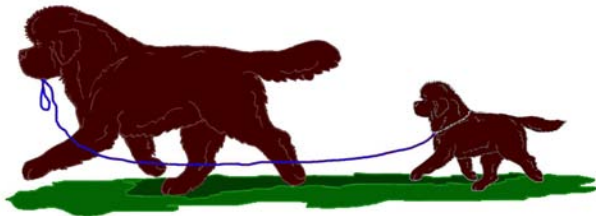

We will start by having our famous breakfast potluck at 10 a.m. followed at 11 a.m by our meeting. This is a great way to meet people and find out about planned activities and when and where they will be held.

Carting Seminars

The Newfoundland Club of Northern California - (NCNC) is happy to announce that they will put on a carting seminar on 19 January 2014 in Walnut Creek and one in Antioch at a date to be announced.

Directions to the seminar site will be provided with registration confirmation.

The faculty will consist of the usual group of NCNC draft and carting experts.

At this time the tentative list of subjects will include;

Beginning Carting - This class is for the beginner and covers, carts, harnesses and how to get your dog involved. Beginners are asked to bring an extra leash.

Intermediate Carting - This class is for graduates from the beginning class. It'll cover sharp turns, negotiating narrows, and teaching your dog to backup.

Draft Test Preparation - This class helps people train for a Newfy draft test but would probably be helpful for people going to other breed's draft test.

Other subjects will be added depending upon the information received with your applications.

A delicious hot lunch is provided only for pre-registered participants.

Carting Seminar Signups

1. Use the attached registration form and send it along with your check to the person shown on the registration form. Participation is by advanced registration only.
2. Fees:
 - \$30 per handler. One handler can work as many dogs as they wish.
 - \$10 - Spectators (lunch provided)
 - \$00 If you volunteer to help the instructors there will be no charge and you'll be provided a lunch.
3. Please give us as much information as possible. The more we know about what you want to learn the better we can meet your needs.
4. Additional lunches for non-participants will be available for \$7.50 but we must know by at least four days prior to the seminar.
5. We must receive sign up registrations at least 4 days prior to the seminar. This will give us time to send you a confirmation and instructions on how to get to the site and to make sure we have enough instructors and helpers..
6. Well behaved and supervised children are welcome.

Event Safety

1. Any dog who is aggressive will be requested to leave.
2. All participants including instructors and other helpers will be asked to sign the club's hold harmless agreement.
3. Handlers will be asked to either have their dogs on leash or in a crate except when they are actually working with the dog such as in the maneuvering course.
4. On freight hauls we will ask people to keep a minimum of 5 foot distance between dogs and when passing let the person ahead know that you are passing.

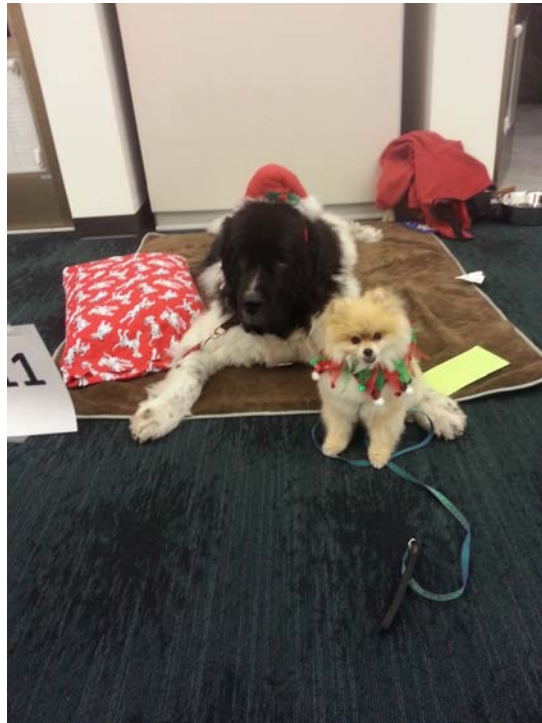
Is your dog a Living Legend (over 10 years of age)?

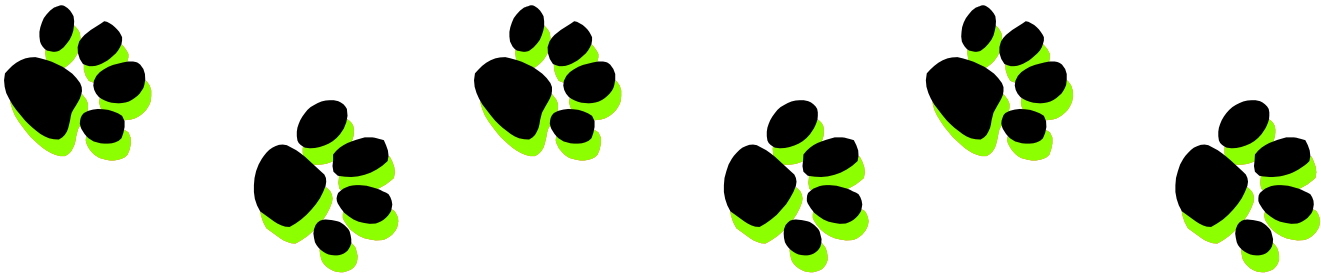
