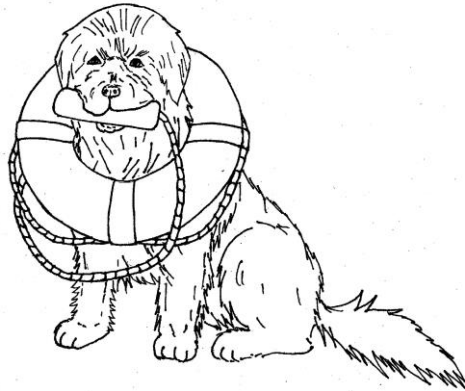

Entry Opening and Closing Dates: Entries open for NCA members on August 13, 2020 (if the dog is co-owned, then either all co-owners of the dog must be NCA members OR the handler must be an NCA member) and open for everyone on August 23, 2020. Entries of NCA members received after August 23 will not be given priority over those of non-NCA members. Entries post marked prior to August 13, 2020 for NCA members and August 23, 2020 for non-NCA members will not be accepted. Closing date for entries is September 14, 2020.

Entry Limits: 25 Dogs each day.

Post entries and move-ups: Dogs earning titles in junior division at each test may post-enter senior division on the same day and may move up to senior division on Sunday if they pass junior on Saturday.

Re-qualifiers: Re-qualifiers will be accepted as space allows and will be judged last in their class. Dogs may be entered in more than one division on the same day but only if they have already qualified at previous tests in all, of the divisions entered. Re-qualifiers in junior division may not post-enter senior division. Check the appropriate boxes on the entry form for the classes entered. If the entry of the test exceeds its limit and a lottery is necessary, the dog may get into each division entered. There will be no substitutions for dogs to change divisions if their entry is chosen for one division but not for the other in a lottery. Judges must excuse any dog not in condition to finish the division entered and if, so the dog will not be able to continue in any other division entered that day. Entry fees will not be refunded for dogs that are excused. Entrants are discouraged from pushing their dogs beyond their limits.

Entry Fee: \$45.00 per entry, \$30.00 for post-entries.

For dogs with WRDs re-qualifying in both junior and senior divisions on the same day, the entry fee is \$75.00 each day.

All fees are payable to the NEWFOUNDLAND CLUB OF NORTHERN CALIFORNIA or NCNC.

Required Forms: Entries must be made on an official NCA entry form, and a copy of the entered dog's AKC, ILP/PAL, or foreign registration paper must be attached.

Water Test Regulations: These tests are conducted in accordance with the NCA Water Test Regulations effective January 1, 1999 and updated March 2018. Exhibitors are responsible for reading and understanding the current regulations in their entirety. Test Regulations are available at a cost of \$4.00 per copy from the NCA Working Dog Committee Publications Contact Dwight Gorsuch, at 6282 Burris Road, Rock Hall, MD 21661-1100. Additional Information

General Personal Guidance

Everyone must take these actions at the test site:

- Do not go to the event if you are sick.
- People who have COVID-19 symptoms should get tested and must isolate unless they have a negative test result. No participant can show evidence of COVID-19 nor have been known exposure to a person with COVID-19 within the last two weeks.
- Follow physical distancing requirements (minimum of 6 feet of space between yourself and others with whom you don't live) except for brief stewarding functions described below.
- Wear a mask. Masks should be worn at all times except when eating, when performing specific stewarding or handling function allowed below (e.g. calling and bobbing stewards, swim with handler and rescue.) If the mask gets wet while working in the water, it becomes ineffective. Bring spares and replace your mask if it gets wet.
- Wash (or sanitize) your hands frequently.

Conduct of Water Test

The test will be conducted in accordance with then current local and state directives regarding gatherings and social distancing. The test also will be conducted in accordance with the NCA Water Test Regulations and WDC COVID-19 Guidance.

Pre-Test Practice: Participants may familiarize themselves with the lake on Friday and after the conclusion of judging on September 26, 2020. No organized practice sessions are currently planned.

Test Site: Folsom Lake in the Granite Bay area has a sloping shoreline with numerous coves. The bottom is granite covered by sand which provides clear water. Swimming depth will be within 20ft or markers will be adjusted per NCA regulation. There is no shade you will need to provide your own.

Directions to Test Site: Exit I-80 at Douglas Blvd. in Roseville east of Sacramento and go south. Douglas Blvd. ends at the park entrance. Further details will be provided in the return of entries.

Where to Stay: There are a number, of motels in the area (Roseville and Folsom) that accept well behaved pets. RV sites may be available at Reserve America Beals Point State Park (916) 791-1531.

Dinners: There will be no pretest or Saturday dinners due to COVID-19 restrictions.

Morning Hospitality: No breakfast will be provided. Please bring your own.

Lunch: Packaged lunches (sandwich, chips, cookie, and bottled water) will be available by pre-order only both days. Each first entry includes one lunch. Please order additional lunches or "opt out" and bring your own on the entry form so we can get an accurate count.

Photographs: Photographs will be available online after the test.

Waiver of Rights – Animals In Distress

The Newfoundland Club of America, Inc, and the regional club hosting this event reserves the right to remove any animal in distress from a parked vehicle or crate, and all persons attending this dog event hereby waives any claim for damages against the Club for such removal. This NCA regards the health, safety and life of any dog on the event grounds to be paramount to other property or privacy rights. If the owner cannot be found in a timely manner, we will take whatever action is necessary for the safety of the dog, which may include breaking windows to enter a vehicle. Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress, or in harm's way (for example, left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress, or harms way is considered mistreatment and subject to appropriate discipline.
