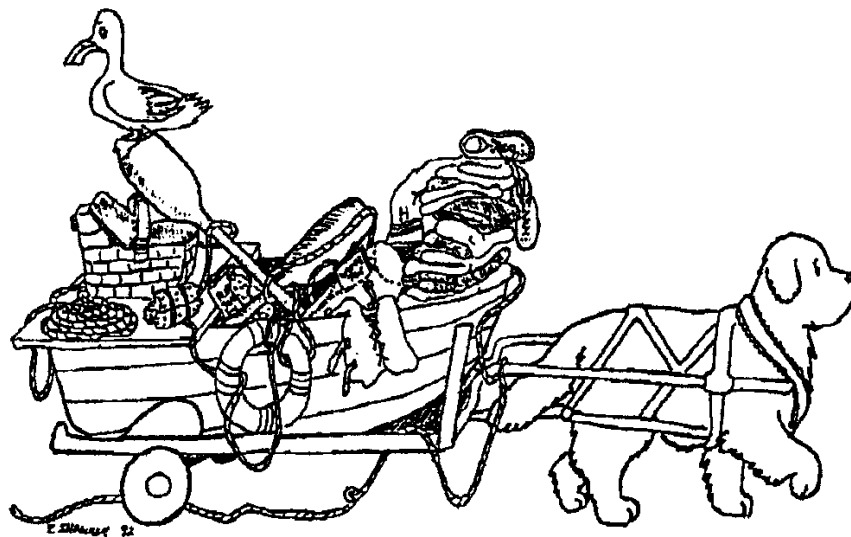

ENTRY LIMITATIONS

Twenty-five Newfoundland entries will be accepted in each test. If less than 3 total entries are received for either test, the test for that day will be cancelled.

If entries fill, an alternate list will be established. Openings will be filled from the alternate list in the order received.

Re-qualifiers will be accepted on a "space available" basis. In other words, untitled dogs will be given priority even if their entry is received after that of a titled dog.

ENTRY FEE: \$45.00 per entry. Entry of the same dog in both WD and WRD on the same day **\$75.00**. Please make checks payable to the Newfoundland Club of Northern California or **NCNC**.

TEST SITE

Description: Folsom Lake is a large freshwater lake with a sandy or rocky shoreline. Swimming depth depends on the water level at the time of the test but will be within 20 feet of shore. **There is NO natural shade so be prepared to provide your own.**

DIRECTIONS TO TEST SITE

From Interstate 80 in Roseville, exit onto Douglas Blvd. South. Follow Douglas until it ends at the Park. There is a \$12.00 fee to enter the park. After passing the kiosk, follow signs to the test site.

Please note that the exact site will be determined shortly before entries close depending of the water level. It may be on the side of the Lake facing Eldorado Hills.

ACCOMMODATIONS

FOOD

Pre-test dinners – No pre-test dinners are planned at this time.

NCA WORKING EVENT AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that the NCA test regulations have been made available to me (us) and that I am (we are) familiar with their contents. I (we) agree that I(we) will uphold the AKC Code of Sportsmanship, the NCA Code of Ethics, and (if applicable) the NCA Judges Code of Ethics. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, or test secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises or grounds and the employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the test premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim or loss of the dog by disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person or any other causes.
