If you are an entrant, a copy of the top half of your “water test record form” is included in the e-mail. If you are entered two days, only one form is appended since they are the same except for the date. Please check the information carefully and if there are errors notify the test secretary as soon as possible so that if you pass, your certificate will be correct. This will save time at check-in on test day.

**NOTE:** Please notify the test secretary as soon as possible if your dog earns a WD (or WRD) before the NCNC test and you wish to move up to senior or excellent division or otherwise change your entry.

**DINNER FRIDAY:** There will be a no-host dinner Friday evening at 6:00 pm. It will be held at Dos Coyotes about 15 minutes from the test site. All participants including exhibitors, judges, committee and stewards are welcome. Please notify me of how many in your party will be attending either by e-mail or on the day of the test. **DIRECTIONS TO THE TEST SITE:** From **Interstate 80** in Roseville, exit onto **Douglas Blvd** and go south. Continue on Douglas Blvd until it ends at the park entrance. There is a parking fee of \$14.00. After passing the kiosk turn right at the first stop sign. When the road ends, turn right. When this road ends turn left and follow the road to the parking lot and 5% boat ramp. There is a trail to the right of the boat ramp.

You will have to port your gear about 100 yds to the actual site. Bring a dolly. If you don't have one, we will have several at the site you can borrow. The barrier at the top of the ramp will be removed to allow you to drive down to the water's edge to unload from 6:30 to 8:30 am and again to load for an interval after the test. After unloading you must immediately return to park in the parking lot at the top of the ramp. We will have signs posted to help you find your way.

**SHADE :** **THERE IS NO NATURAL SHADE.** Although we will have some canopies set up at the test site, please bring your own shade if possible.

**LUNCHES:** If you have not notified the test secretary of how many in your party will be having lunch on Saturday and Sunday, please do so ASAP. Lunches are free for exhibitors **on the day they are tested.**

**MOTELS:** Check the internet for pet friendly motels in the Roseville, Rocklin areas.

8:45 AM Equipment check and judges' instructions to Excellent Division exhibitors  
9:00 AM Start of Excellent Division judging

At the conclusion of excellent division judging: Junior Division pre-swim for 15 minutes and judges' instructons to Junior Division stewards

Followed by: Judges' instructions to Junior Division exhibitors  
Junior division judging

At the conclusion of Junior division judging: Senior Division pre-swim for 15 minutes and judges' instructons to Senior Division stewards

Followed by: Judges' instructions to Senior Division exhibitors  
Senior division judging

LUNCH At the discretion of the judges.

**SPECIAL ATTRACTION both days:** A Great Dane will be tested in the regular Newf exercises at the conclusion of WRD judging.

### Sunday, August 7

The schedule for Sunday will be the same as that for Saturday except that there will be no dinner.

**NOTE:** THE RULES IN EFFECT JANUARY 1999 STATE THAT BITCHES IN SEASON AT ONE-DAY TESTS WILL BE JUDGED AFTER ALL ENTRIES IN ALL DIVISIONS INCLUDING ANY POST-ENTRIES. IF YOUR BITCH IS IN SEASON, PLEASE NOTIFY THE TEST SECRETARY PRIOR TO THE START OF JUDGING. BITCHES IN SEASON **MUST** BE KEPT OUT OF THE TEST AREA AND AWAY FROM THE OTHER DOGS UNTIL CALLED FOR BY THE JUDGES.
