**If you are an entrant, a copy of your "water test record form" is attached to this e-mail. Please check the information carefully and if there are errors notify the test secretary as soon as possible so that if you pass, your certificate will be correct. This will save time at check-in on test day.**

**NOTE:** Please notify the test secretary as soon as possible if your dog earns a WD (or WRD) before the NCNC test and you wish to move up to senior or excellent division or otherwise change your entry.

**DINNER FRIDAY AT 6:00 PM:** There will be a no-host dinner at El Dorado Saloon & Grill about 15 minutes from the test site; 879 Embarcadero Dr., El dorado Hills. From Brown's Ravine Marina turn left on Green Valley Rd. The restaurant is at the corner of Green Valley and Rd and Francisco Dr.

**DINNER SATURDAY AT 5:00 PM:** A no-host dinner will be held at Mexquite Mexican Restaurant; 25095 Blue Ravine Rd., Folsom CA. From Brown's Ravine Marina turn right on Green Valley Rd. and go two miles, turn left (south) onto East Natoma St, then right into the shopping center.

**All participants are welcome to attend both dinners. Both have outdoor seating with dog allowed. Please contact John Pearson at [waterdog@ix.netcom.com](mailto:waterdog@ix.netcom.com) for further information. For Friday especially it would be helpful to let John know if you are attending before Friday. For Saturday let him know before the end of the test day.**

**DIRECTIONS TO THE TEST SITE:** From Interstate 50 in Folsom, exit at Folsom Blvd and go north. Continue on Folsom for 1.5 miles and turn right on Blue Ravine Rd. After 4.6 miles Blue Ravine becomes Green Valley Rd at E. Natoma St. Continue past E Natoma for 2.2 miles and turn left into the Brown's Ravine Marina. Look for a small sign just before the Marina.

From Interstate 80, exit at Douglas Blvd and turn east. Follow Douglas 5.1 miles to Auburn-Folsom Rd and turn right. After 2.8 miles turn left on Folsom Lake Crossing and follow it over the hill and past the dam. It becomes E. Natoma St. Turn left on Green Valley and go 2.2 miles to Brown's Ravine Marina on the left.

After turning into the road to the marina continue past the kiosk (pay \$14 for parking) and follow the road to the last parking lot on the left. Turn left and follow along the top of the lot until you get to a dirt road that takes you down to the water.

**SHADE : THERE IS NO NATURAL SHADE.** Although we will have some canopies set up at the test site, please bring your own shade if possible.

**LUNCHES:** If you have not notified the test secretary of how many in your party will be having lunch on Saturday and Sunday, please do so ASAP. Lunches are free for exhibitors **on the day they are tested.**

**MOTELS:** Check the internet for pet friendly motels in the Roseville, Rocklin areas.

Followed by: Judges' instructions to Senior Division exhibitors

The schedule for Sunday will be the same as that for Saturday except that there will be no WRDX judging and junior division pre-swim will begin at 8:00.

**NOTE:** THE RULES IN EFFECT JANUARY 1999 STATE THAT BITCHES IN SEASON AT ONE-DAY TESTS WILL BE JUDGED AFTER ALL ENTRIES IN ALL DIVISIONS INCLUDING ANY POST-ENTRIES. IF YOUR BITCH IS IN SEASON, PLEASE NOTIFY THE TEST SECRETARY PRIOR TO THE START OF JUDGING. BITCHES IN SEASON **MUST** BE KEPT OUT OF THE TEST AREA AND AWAY FROM THE OTHER DOGS UNTIL CALLED FOR BY THE JUDGES.
